Bike to Build is a collaborative fundraiser held by Habitat for Humanity Clinton County.

Bicycle riders can choose 75, 50, 20 mile rides. All routes begin and end at Northpointe Community Church at 505 E Webb Dr, Dewitt, MI 48820. Riders will be served lunch between 10:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. back at Northpointe Community Church. All routes will pass through at least one rest stop with volunteers serving assorted refreshments.

By participating and raising funds for Bike to Build you will be partnering with Habitat for Humanity to eliminate substandard housing in your communities.
